Reflect supports children, aged 3-18 and their families who live in the Western Cheshire area.

The service offers counselling services, training, consultation, advice and information, sharing of best practice to individuals, schools and other agencies.

When working one to one with children both at the Hospice and in the wider community the children often feedback that they would like to meet other young people in the same position as them. In response to this we hold Remembering events. These are opportunities for children, young people and their families to meet one another and share their experiences together.

The last event, a story telling day, was held in May and was the first time the children were invited to share their day with an adult. The children and young people were then encouraged to write, draw and tell their own story. The Reflect counsellors were joined by a story teller, Kay who brought their stories to life which helped the children engage with each other and make new friends. Kay also shared practical information regarding support groups and had an opportunity to share time together. The event was sponsored by the charity “Elise Ever After” who also donated books and encouraged volunteers to attend and provide support on the day.

In a relaxed setting, people were invited to remember their loved ones and share their experiences. Games were played, including making flying elder planes, ball and ball, and people amongst others.

A superb lunchtime feast was served by the Hospice catering team, finished with an amazing chocolate profiterole mountain dessert, the topping of strawberries, raspberries and malted sherbet was very memorable.

Sharing stories at the end of the day was a highlight as children supported each other and listened to their experiences. Everyone enjoyed the day with one adult saying “We can’t believe what a difference you make it’s been a life line”. For another adult their highlight was when a five year old girl was brave enough to share her story and a ten year old boy leaned over and gave her a high five. A parent was able to say “It amazes me how important these days are to my son, I realise that he has a need to be with other children who understand his story and for him to be able to talk about his Mum.”

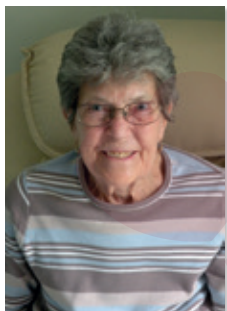

Gladys's Home From Home



Having spent a lot of time in and out of hospitals for over 20 years, and after four straight weeks in Pinderfields, Gladys Barrett was understandably cautious about the possibility of coming to The Prince of Wales Hospice. She needed some persuading from family that the care she would receive at the hospice was just what she needed.

"To be honest I was really afraid of going to a hospice. I thought it was just a cancer place and somewhere I was going to die."

On arrival, Gladys's commonly held beliefs about hospice care were quickly dismissed as she came to

understand that the hospice was also there to support people who needed help managing their symptoms.

In hospital, Gladys had found she often had to wait for pain relief because the wards were so busy. So, one of the first differences Gladys noticed about care at the hospice was that nurses were able to treat any ache or pain immediately. She was also surprised to notice that the atmosphere felt better, as staff weren't rushing about, and says she never heard anyone 'having a grumble'.

"All the staff are just so caring and happy to help with anything at all."

When the nursing staff offered her the opportunity to have a Jacuzzi bath, Gladys jumped at the chance. "I only have a shower at home so it was absolute luxury for me and I couldn't believe that there was no rush to it, I could take my time."

"I've felt so calm and relaxed here... It's like being in a home from home."

Gladys managed, with the care and support of the team at the hospice, to get her symptoms under control and was able to return home with additional support the hospice had arranged.

"Because of the care I received at the hospice, I'm a very different person to when I first arrived."

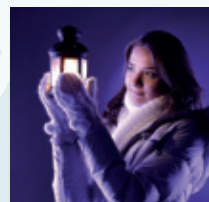

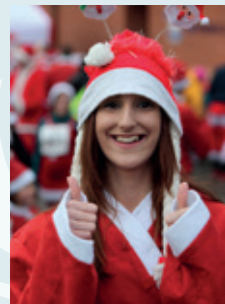
